Rev. Dr. Iain D Campbell: After finishing his studies at the Free Church College, Iain served in Snizort, Back, and presently in Point in the Isle of Lewis. His doctoral research on George Adam Smith was published in a book called, *Fixing the Indemnity*. He is an Adjunct Professor of Church History at Westminster Theological Seminary. He also has written several other books. His topic will be on Rob Bell's new book, *Love Wins - Who Loses?*

Rev. David Meredith: David was ordained to Smithton Culloden on leaving college in 1984. David was elected Moderator of the Free Church in 2010 and is a well known conference speaker. Recently, the church at Smithton built a new extension and there is a sense of encouragement in the way the work is developing under his leadership. His topic will be 'Preaching hell pastorally'.

Gareth Burke: Minister of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church since 1984. Currently minister of the Stranmillis congregation in Belfast. His topic will be on 'WP Nicholson, God's rough diamond'.

Rev. Derek Lamont: Derek, after working as an assistant to Kenny MacDonald, Roskeen, was called to be their minister when Kenny retired. He is now the minister of St. Columba's in Edinburgh. The congregation there has been blessed under his leadership and is seeing encouraging signs of growth. His topic will be 'Change, not decay, in all around I see - effecting change in a congregation'.

Rev Dr. Malcolm Maclean: After graduating from the Free Church College, Malcolm was called to Scalpay. He is now the minister of Greyfriars in Inverness. He is still involved with editorial duties with Christian Focus. He has written a book called, *The Lord's Supper*, which has been well received. His topic will be 'KJV 400'.

Rev. James Maciver: James is the Moderator of the Free Church and is presently the minister in Knock Free Church. He also presides as the Senior Clerk of the Assembly. His first ministry was with the East Kilbride congregation. His topic is on 'Revelation 20'.
