### Dumisani Correspondence Courses

At Dumisani Theological Institute the Bible Correspondence Courses are very important. They are the entry level into the college. After completing them, many students go on to register for the main courses and attend classes at Dumisani. They are also greatly used in prison ministry. Almost 100 prisoners are using the material in 8 prisons throughout South Africa. Prisoners testify to the great impact this has had on their lives. Funds are needed to translate the courses from English into Xhosa and also for publishing them in a modern format.
